Frequently Asked Questions:

1. When is recycling picked up?

2. What can I recycle?

3. Am I limited to the number of containers I put out?

No, there is no limit to the number of containers picked up.

4. Do I need to separate plastics, newspapers or cardboard?

No, you put all the materials in the same containers.

5. I missed the curbside recycling day. Can I bring my recyclables somewhere to be recycled?

Yes, certain recyclables (ex. leaves, brush) can be brought to the **Township Recycling Center**, located at 10 Mansfield Drive and open Mondays through Fridays from 8am to 3pm. In addition, the Recycling Center is open (and staffed) the second Saturday of each month from 9am to 1pm. Please note that the **Leaf and Brush recycling area of the Recycling Center will be closed from December 19th through March 30th** due to winter weather. Residents may also opt to bring their recyclables to the **Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authorities (SCMUA)**. SCMUA is located at 34 South Route 94, Lafayette, NJ

and is open for disposal Monday through Saturday from 7am to 2pm. Residents may call the office at 973-579-6998 Monday through Friday from 8:30am to 4:30pm. Note that fees are collected for this service, unless it is done on a special recycling / disposal day. For additional information on SCMUA, [click here](#).

SCMUA designates special FREE disposal days throughout the year for items such as [Electronics](#) and [Household Hazardous Wastes](#). Click on each topic to obtain detailed information, including the posted dates.

6. Can I use plastic bags to hold my recyclables?

No, recyclables will NOT be picked up if it is in plastic bags, unless you are recycling shredded paper. Shredded paper should be collected in clear plastic bags only.

7. Why does the list of items to recycle keep changing?

Byram keeps current on state requirements and as such, modifications may be needed. Please check the website to keep informed.

8. Does Byram Township sell recyclables that are collected?

Yes, Byram Township has contracted with ReCommunity Recycling for the sale of our recyclables. For every ton of materials that is not taken to the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority, Byram Township will save nearly \$100 in tipping fees and also receives \$18 per ton of items recycled!
