

BYRAM TOWNSHIP GARBAGE INFORMATION

GARBAGE PICK-UP / CURBSIDE: Service Provided by Blue Diamond (973) 598-9800	Every Tuesday*, between 6am and 6pm at curbside. Trash must be placed at curbside no later than 6am on Tuesday, OR trash may be placed at curbside after 5pm on the preceding day (Monday).
	After collection, all containers must be removed by 7pm of the day of collection.
	Up to two (2) 45 gallon containers per week are permitted, each weighing no more than 40 lbs.
	* unless incimate weather prohibits the regular pick-up, in which an attempt will be made to pick up the following day (not on Sundays). If on a holiday, the pick-up will occur the following day. Please be patient as there may be delays due to extra volume.
WHAT IS PICKED UP CURBSIDE:	One (1) Bulk Item per week (ex. sofa, chair, dresser, mattress, desk, carpets rolled in <6' sections, exercise equipment such as treadmill ONLY if less than 50% metal, etc.).
	Solid Waste and Plastic Items (ex. bags, hangars, toys, flowerpots), Styrofoam, Pie Trays, Egg Cartons.
	Christmas Trees will be picked up in January, date to be determined. For 2020, this will occur on January 13 th (weather dependent). Please ensure all lights, decorations and tinsel is removed.
	Batteries - Alkaline batteries only. Rechargeable batteries can be brought to the Township Municipal Building. Car/boat/lawn tractor batteries can brought to Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority.

WHAT NEEDS TO BE BROUGHT TO SUSSEX COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY (SCMUA): 34 South Route 94, Lafayette, NJ 973-579-6998 Open Mon. to Sat. from 7am to 2pm	E Waste (ex. computers, printers, televisions, stereo equipment, VCRs, DVD and CD players, fax machines, copiers, radios and other electronic media) - SCMUA designates special free E Waste Disposal Days during the year. 2019 dates are 3/30, 5/11, 7/20 and 10/19. Click here for SCMUA flyer.
	Hazardous Waste (ex. paints, oil, chemicals, insecticides, pesticides, driveway sealer, etc.) - SCMUA designates special free Hazardous Waste Disposal Days during the year. 2019 dates are 6/1 and 11/2.
	Construction Materials (ex. concrete, sheetrock, tiles, wood, toilets, sinks, vanities, siding, flooring, shingles, siding, gutters, windows, railroad ties, etc.) can be brought year round to SCMUA for a nominal fee.
	Rigid Plastics (ex. patio furniture, household plastic items like storage containers, tubs, shelving, plastic toys such as little tykes, big wheels, plastic buckets) may be brought to SCMUA for disposal.
	Other Items - fluorescent light bulbs, liquid medical waste or needles, car/boat/lawn tractor batteries, air conditioners, flags, etc. can be brought year round to SCMUA for a nominal fee.
	Metals (ex. appliances such as stove, dishwasher, refrigerator with doors removed, microwave, etc.). Grills are accepted at the Recycling Center <u>after</u> the propane tank has been removed (<u>tanks are not accepted</u> in Byram, but may be brought to SCMUA for disposal).
NEED TO BRING TO BYRAM TWP. RECYCLING CENTER: 10 Mansfield Drive Stanhope, NJ 07874 973-347-2500x138 Open daily during daylight hours; Leaf and Brush area is closed during winter months (typically mid-Dec. through end of March, weather dependent)	Auto Tires (With Rims Removed) - Byram Twp. will designate special days when Auto Tires may be accepted at the Twp. Municipal Recycling Center. Dates will be posted on our website. Tires can be brought to SCMUA year round with a disposal fee.
	Leaves - Although leaves placed in biodegradable bags will be picked up curbside during special Leaf Pick-up days (11/11 and 12/9/19, weather dependent), residents may bring leaves to the Twp. Municipal Recycling Center when the Leaf/Brush area is open during daylight hours 7 days a week. Note that this area is monitored 24 hours a day, 7 days a week with security cameras. Typically this area is closed from mid Dec. through the end of March due to winter weather conditions. However, there is the possibility that this area may close earlier than mid Dec. and/or may not open till late April as this is dependent upon the weather. Please call the Township to confirm the dates this area will close and open.
	Brush - brush/branches less than 4" in diameter can be brought to the Twp. Municipal Recycling Center when the Leaf/Brush area is open. See "Leaves" for dates/times. Note that brush is a separate area from leaves.
	Medical Waste - pills, tablets and capsules can be recycled at the Byram Twp. Police Dept. Liquids and needles need to be brought to SCMUA.
	Cell Phones/Rechargeable Batteries - can be recycled at Byram Twp. Municipal Building.
