

BYRAM TOWNSHIP RECYCLING INFORMATION

RECYCLING PICK-UP / CURBSIDE:	Every other Friday*, at curbside, between 6am and 6pm. Containers must be placed curbside by 6am on the scheduled pick-up day, OR may be placed curbside after 5pm on the preceding day.
	After collection, all containers must be removed by 7pm of the day of collection.
	Recyclables can be mixed together in the same containers (do not put them in plastic bags) and there is no limit to the number of containers used. Shredded paper must be in clear plastic bags only.
	* unless incimate weather prohibits the regular pick-up, in which an attempt will be made to pick up the following day (not on Sundays). If on a holiday, the pick-up will occur the following day. Please be patient as there may be delays due to extra volume.
WHAT IS PICKED UP CURBSIDE:	Glass - food and beverage jars and bottles.
	Plastics - stamped with #1 through 7, including jars, bottles and jugs.
	Aluminum and Metal Cans, Foil, Steel Bottle Caps.
	Paper Products - newspaper, magazines, brochures, cardboard, paper towel and toilet paper rolls, paper bags, paperback and hard cover books, cartons, cards, junk mail, phone books, file folders, cardboard beverage carriers, dry food cartons, pizza boxes, etc.
	Leaves - twice a year on designated days, leaves placed in biodegradable bags will be picked up curbside. Residents may also bring leaves to the Township Recycling Center (see below) when Leaf/Brush area is open.
	Christmas Trees - will be picked up the week of January 9th (weather dependent). Please ensure tinsels and any decorations are removed.
WHAT IS NOT PICKED UP CURBSIDE:	Items that are considered Garbage. Click here for link.
WHAT NEEDS TO BE BROUGHT TO SUSSEX COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY (SCMUA): <i>34 South Route 94, Lafayette, NJ 973-579-6998 Open Mon. to Sat. from 7am to 2pm</i>	Construction Materials (ex. concrete, sheetrock, tiles, wood, toilets, sinks, vanities, siding, flooring, etc.) can be brought year round to SCMUA for a nominal fee.
	E Waste (ex. computers, printers, televisions, stereo equipment and other electronic media) - SCMUA designates special free E Waste Disposal Days during the year. 2017 dates will be determined in March and will be posted on our website.
	Hazardous Waste (ex. paints, oil, chemicals, insecticides, pesticides, driveway sealer, etc.) - SCMUA designates special free Hazardous Waste Disposal Days during the year. 2017 dates will be determined in March and will be posted on our website.
	Other Items - fluorescent light bulbs, liquid medical waste or needles, car/boat/lawn tractor batteries, flags, etc. can be brought year round to SCMUA for a nominal fee.

RECYCLING CENTER: <i>10 Mansfield Drive Stanhope, NJ 07874 973-347-2500x138 Open Mon. to Fri. 8am-3pm and the 2nd Sat. of each month from 9am-1pm (with assistance available on Sat. if needed)</i>	Metals (ex. appliances such as stove, dishwasher, refrigerator with doors removed, microwave, etc.).
	Rigid Plastics (ex. patio furniture, laundry baskets, household plastic items like storage containers, tubs, shelving, plastic toys such as little tykes, big wheels, plastic buckets, plastic pallets and skids) - Byram Twp. will designate special days when Rigid Plastics will be accepted at the Twp. Municipal Recycling Center. Dates will be posted on our website.
	Leaves - Although leaves placed in biodegradable bags will be picked up curbside during special Leaf Pick-up days (dates will be posted on our website), residents may bring leaves to the Twp. Municipal Recycling Center when the Leaf/Brush area is open. The Leaf/Brush area is independent of the Recycling Center and is open during daylight hours 7 days a week except between December 19-March 30 when it is closed due to winter weather. It is expected to open again April 1, weather dependent. note that this area is monitored 24 hours a day 7 days a week with security cameras.
	Brush - brush/branches less than 4" in diameter can be brought to the Twp. Municipal Recycling Center when the Leaf/Brush area is open. See "Leaves" for dates/times.
	Auto Tires (With Rims Removed) - Byram Twp. will designate special days when Auto Tires will be accepted at the Twp. Municipal Recycling Center. Dates will be posted on our website.
	Medical Waste - pills, tablets and capsules can be recycled at the Byram Twp. Police Dept. Liquids and needles (sharps) need to be brought to SCMUA.
	Cell Phones/Rechargeable Batteries - can be recycled at Byram Twp. Municipal Building.
